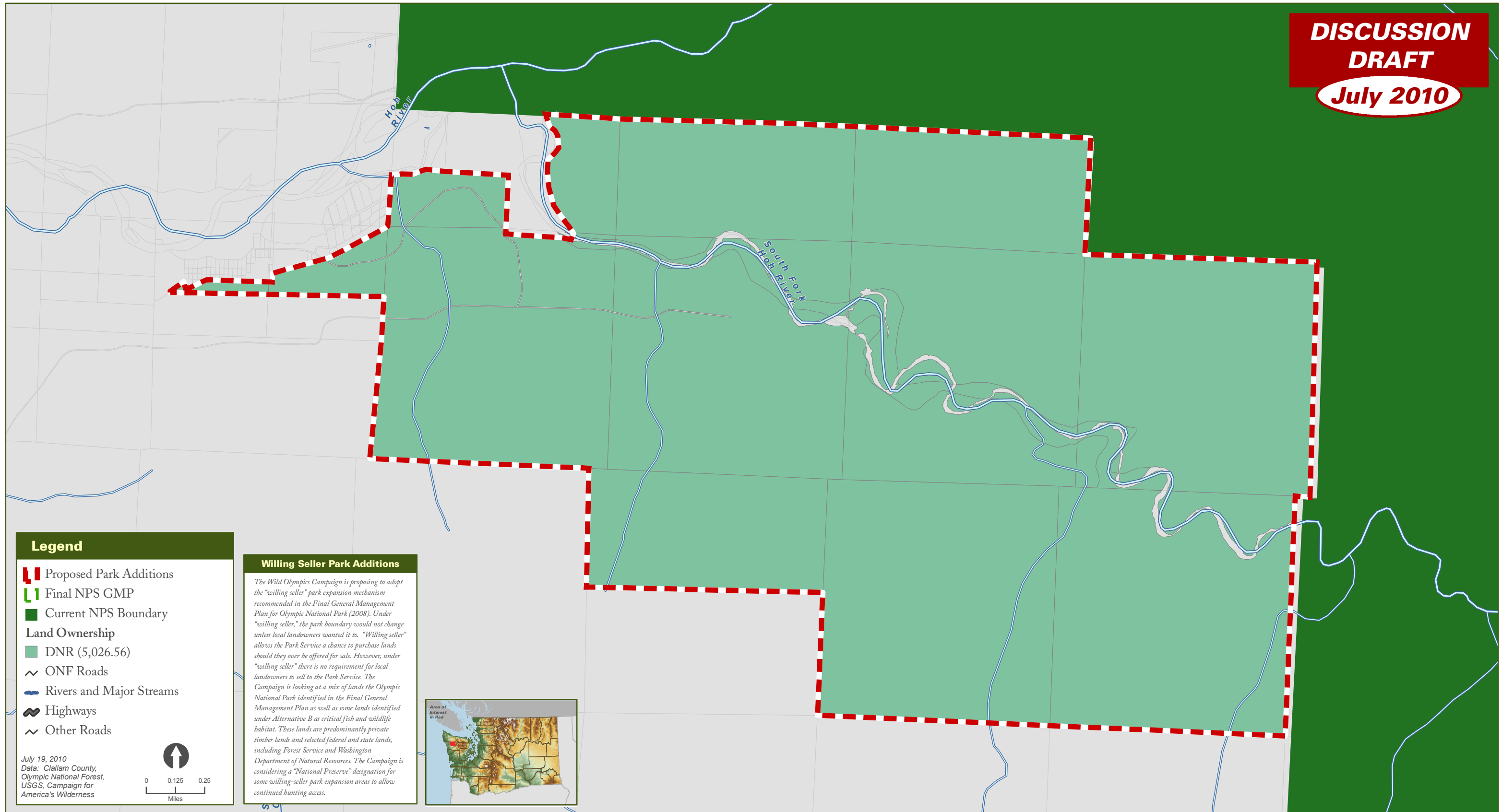

Willing Seller Park Additions

The Wild Olympics Campaign is proposing to adopt the "willing seller" park expansion mechanism recommended in the Final General Management Plan for Olympic National Park (2008). Under "willing seller," the park boundary would not change unless local landowners wanted it to. "Willing seller" allows the Park Service a chance to purchase lands should they ever be offered for sale. However, under "willing seller" there is no requirement for local landowners to sell to the Park Service. The Campaign is looking at a mix of lands the Olympic National Park identified in the Final General Management Plan as well as some lands identified under Alternative B as critical fish and wildlife habitat. These lands are predominantly private timber lands and selected federal and state lands, including Forest Service and Washington Department of Natural Resources. The Campaign is considering a "National Preserve" designation for some willing-seller park expansion areas to allow continued hunting access.
